Thank you for your interest in volunteering at ClearView Community Church.

There are many places for you to serve here and our desire is to find the perfect place for you! This packet will give you an overview of what the requirements are to volunteer, what is expected from a volunteer, and what support volunteers can expect from the church leadership.

What is required?

Volunteers are required to be regular attendees of ClearView. We do not have official membership but regular attendance in our fellowship is crucial to volunteering and being involved in the ministries of ClearView.

Volunteers in any leadership or teaching role (this includes all areas involving children or youth) are required to have accepted Jesus Christ as their personal savior and be able to relate and share that experience with others.

Volunteers are required to attend a ClearView 101 class or read the ClearView 101 booklet if attending a class is not possible. Volunteers must agree with the statements of faith and purpose of ClearView Community Church as described in ClearView 101.

Volunteers are expected to fulfill the time requirements of their particular position. If they cannot do so it is their responsibility to let their ministry head know and find a substitute if appropriate.

Volunteers are required to be accountable to the head of the ministry they are involved in and to the Elders and pastoral staff. Any problems should first be taken to the head of the ministry and then to the pastoral staff.

What can I expect?

We want you to succeed in your service at ClearView and will do our best to provide you with the support you need to do that.

You can expect to be trained for the position you are volunteering for. The amount of training will vary depending on the job.

You can expect to be placed in an area of service that fits your gifts and talents.
