



## Read 1 Peter

Read the book of 1 Peter. There are 105 verses in its 5 chapters.  
BONUS: read the whole book every day!

**Read Mark 13.** Do you see any of Jesus' prophecies coming true in the news? Amid the dire warnings, Jesus gives many commands we can apply every day. For example, He says in verse 7, "Do not be alarmed." Make a list of all of the commands in this chapter. I found 14, can you find more?

*All sin causes suffering* It's impossible to sin and not feel its painful sting. What do these passages reveal about sin as a cause of suffering?

Deuteronomy 28      Joshua 7      Psalm 107:17  
Proverbs 13:21    23:29-30    24:30-34    26:27    28:17-22  
Acts 5:1-11  
Hebrews 12:3-11

*But not all suffering is caused by sin!*

What other sources of suffering do you see in these passages? What is the point of this pain?

Genesis 50:19-21      Job 1  
John 9:1-2  
Luke 8:42-48    13:1-12  
1 Peter 3:18    4:1

*Elect Exiles* Read Jeremiah 29:1-14. Verse 11 is a perennial favorite. Does the context around verse 11 surprise you? In the midst of our exile, what promises does God make?

*Confident & Unashamed* Read 1 John 2:28. Do you believe it's possible to be "confident and unashamed" before Christ when He returns?
