## 2021 ART EXHIBIT SUBMISSION FORM

Submissions are now being accepted for our second annual visual art exhibit at ClearView Community Church, *Reflections: New Life!* In the Gospel of John, Jesus declares that He has come to give us life, and life in abundance under His care and protection. Reflections 2021 will celebrate and extrapolate this concept of life in Christ.

The exhibit will be on display Sunday March 7 through Easter Sunday, April 4. A video is available on the Reflections page of the church website which walks through and explains this entire form. ### GUIDELINES

#### Artwork Eligibility

- All submitters must be regular attenders of ClearView Community Church.
- Submissions must be preceded by this form, completed in its entirety.
- All forms of visual media are encouraged! (painting, drawing, photography, graphic design, film, ceramics, etc.)

#### Selection Process

- All submissions will be reviewed by the Worship Pastor. Art will be selected on the basis of general quality as well as sustainability for this exhibit.
- Exhibit space is reserved on a first-come, first-served basis. Please see the deadlines below.
- The Worship Pastor may request a sample image of your concept or schedule a brief meeting to discuss your submission and concept.

#### Deadlines

- Submission Forms must be submitted to Pastor Brandon for review by **Sunday February 21, 2021.**
- Actual pieces/media are due to Pastor Brandon at the church by **Sunday February 28, 2021.**
- Artwork must be retrieved by **Sunday April 25, 2021.** Artwork not retrieved by this date will be considered property of ClearView Community Church to be used, stored, or given away as it sees fit.

#### Additional Guideline Information

- Each artist can display up to 3 separately framed pieces.
- For 2D: artwork must not exceed 60" (5ft) on its longest side.
- For 3D (sculptures, etc.): artwork must be under 100 lb and must not exceed 60" (5ft) on its longest side.
- **All artwork must be professionally displayed.** Please ensure 2D artwork such as paintings and photographs are properly framed or otherwise prepared for display with no unfinished edges. ***PLEASE MAKE SURE ANY 2D ART IS DELIVERED READY TO HANG WITH A HOOK OR WIRE ON THE BACK. DO NOT DELIVER A WOODEN CANVAS WITH NO HOOKS OR WIRES PLEASE.*** Pillars and/or display tables will be provided by ClearView for 3D artwork.
- Artwork location in the exhibit will be determined by the Worship Pastor.
